I am a safety professional with over 30 years working within construction industry and over 20 years of H&S experience, predominately working within the rail sector. I set up my own H&S Services business in 2023 to provide my services for Health and Safety Management to potentially new customers. I also have H&S consultancy experience working with customers and clients within the Construction, Manufacturing and Engineering environments across the Southwest area with WTC. I have previously been employed by Alstom D&IS (Digital Integrated Systems) as the Wales & Western Regional EHS Manager on signalling projects between London and Bristol, including the EHS Manager for the Infrastructure & Turnkey Projects (Heathrow T5) and the Irish Rail ETCS project, I have managed teams of advisors supporting EHS and CDM on Paddington to Reading/HS2 Projects and Bristol Area Signalling projects, including supporting a number of new CP6 (Control Period) projects awarded as part of the MSFA (Major signalling framework agreements). I have previously worked for the client organisations with Network Rail within Projects as a H&S Manager, managing HSEA teams in the West of England Area Electrification schemes and have worked in the rail industry for over 30 years; I joined the railway with B.R. in the Signal & Telecoms organisation, carrying out faulting & maintenance of railway signalling & telecoms equipment. For over 20 years I have worked in various Health & Safety and consultancy roles & locations across the country supporting clients, maintenance functions and project organisations deliver their Health & Safety.

I have experience of delivering CDM (Construction Design Management) as Client & Principal Contractor within a number of projects, coaching safety within the maintenance delivery units and supporting safety representatives and management teams with compliance towards safety legislation and process. My H&S experiences have included working within high value project schemes with West Coast Projects supporting client project teams at Nuneaton and Rugby with HSQE, Projects Enhancements working in the LNE (York) & LNW (Manchester) areas, Reading Area Station Redevelopment (£850 million) and the development of a new H&S role as the Network Rail H&S Manager for IP Wales region working between Cardiff and Bristol.

While working as an Alstom Regional EHS Manager I attained considerable management experience of working with senior teams and leading safety with our contractors and suppliers supported by my team of advisors, this included supporting the client with regular updates and period end reporting with KPI's and reports, my position and role also included deputising for the Head of Safety for the D&IS business. I have solid understanding of accident & incident investigations (Formal & Local) producing reports, alerts, safety briefs and undertaking internal and external audits, team leading and development and mentoring of staff. I have experience of checking compliance and competence towards current HSE legislation and railway group standards which include audit support for our ISO's (45001,9001,14001) RISQ's (Railway Industry Supplier Qualification Scheme) I have also been the UK D&IS businesses point of contact for our CDM Principal Contractors licensing scheme, I have managed and delivered behavioural safety programmes and developed and implemented improvements and initiatives.

I have attained a number of Signal & Telecoms engineering and Health Safety Environment and Assurance qualifications including memberships of IOSH (Chartered) IEMA & IRSE (Institute of Rail Signal Engineers). As a competent L₃ trainer I have delivered various H&S training internal and external to contractors, my clients were varied across a number of disciplines which included Construction, Engineering, Manufacturing and government bodies (The Met Office).
